#### 4.2 **Cut off date for Age and Relaxations :-**

Crucial date for determining the age limit will be the closing date i.e. 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2018 (31/01/2018). Candidates should not have been born **earlier** than 01/02/1993 and not later than 31/01/2000.

#### Note:-

- (ii) The candidates must not have knock knee, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in eyes;
- (iii) Must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.
- (iii) An colour blind person will not be eligible for appointment. If at any stage of service career, person is found to be colour blind, he will be boarded out as per SHAPE policy in vogue in the force;

#### (iv) <u>Tattoos</u>: -

- (a) <u>Content</u>: Being a secular country, the religious sentiments of our countrymen are to be respected and thus, tattoos depicting religious symbol or figures and the name, as followed in Indian Army are to be permitted.
- (b) <u>Location</u>: Tattoos marked on traditional sites of the body like inner aspect of forearm but only left forearm, being non saluting limb or dorsum of the hands are to be allowed.
- (c) <u>Size</u>: Size must be less than ¼ of the particular part (Elbow or Hand) of the body.

- 5.1 Eligible and interested candidates should apply only through website www.recruitment.itbpolice.nic.in. Candidates are advised to fill the application form after reading the instructions carefully. The application must be submitted ONLINE only. No application will be accepted offline. Candidature of the candidate who submitted application offline will be rejected summarily.
  - Written test for both posts will be held on same day/time. Hence, candidates are advised to apply for only one post. If more than one application are filled by the candidates all applications are liable to be summarily rejected.

#### 7. APPEAL AGAINST DME:-
